# PREMIER™ HONEYCRISP



- PP# 24,833 (DAS 10 Cltv.)
- Harvests a good 3 weeks ahead of standard Honeycrisp
- Picks 3-4 days ahead of Ginger Gold® in Adams County, PA
- Distinctive red stripe strain with very good storage qualities
- Same weak growth habit as original parent

# CRIMSON CRISP®



- PP#16,622 (CO-OP 39)
- Origin: Purdue-Rutgers Coop
- Tart, sweet flavor
- Flexible harvest date – variety will hang up to three weeks on tree
- Tolerates heat; no sunburn observed to date
- Scab-resistant
- Late blooming
- Not resistant to fire blight, powdery mildew or cedar apple rust
- Favorable feedback from direct marketers, pick-you-own and hard cider makers

# 2017 PEACH AVAILABILITY

- There will be shortages for 2017 due to our short crop of trees and major tree losses west of Pennsylvania throughout the other peach growing districts
- Encourage growers to plan ahead early and order ASAP for 2017 and 2018

# NECSTAR™ AVALON™



- (NJN101 Cltv.) PP#23,882
- Harvest 10 days before Redhaven
- Out performs others in its season when it comes to color, flavor and productivity
- Exhibits high tolerance to bacterial spot

# JULY ROSE™



- (NJ354 Cltv.) PP#23,669
- A very attractive early-season freestone white peach
- Vigorous producer of firm, sweet fruit
- Picks about a week before Redhaven
- Highly tolerant of bacterial leaf spot

# H21-44



- New Rutgers release coming...
- Yellow-fleshed nectarine
- Semi-freestone
- Ripens a week before Redhaven
- Solid scarlet coloring
- Nice, acidic flavor



# K54-42



- New Rutgers release coming...
- White semi-clingstone nectarine
- Ripens before Redhaven, after Sentry
- **Larger** and more attractive than other whites in its season
- Nice, acidic flavor

# SCARLET ROSE™



- (NJ355 Ctlv.) PP#23,883
- Early season white clingstone
- Great eating qualities
- Mildly sub-acid
- Picks a few days before Redhaven
- Follows July Rose™
- Firm fruit hangs well on the tree for up to two weeks after maturity without significant loss of quality

# PRELIMINARY H7-47



- New Rutgers release coming...
- Semi-freestone yellow-fleshed peach
- Low acid
- Ripens with Redhaven
- Overlaps White Lady
- Very firm fruit
- Large size
- Very attractive, full scarlet coloring
- High tolerance to bacterial leaf spot

# AUGUST ROSE™



- (NJ356 Cltv.) PP#23,884
- A very attractive late season white fleshed freestone peach
- Picks about 4 weeks or more after Redhaven with a long hang time
- Replaces Snow King season
- Great eating qualities
- Fruit exhibits a pleasant rose aroma
- Flavor mildly sub-acid to acid
- High tolerance to bacterial spot and constriction canker

# PRESENCE K64-197



- New Rutgers release coming...
- Late-season yellow freestone peach
- Ripens around Encore season, 32 days after Redhaven
- Nice, acidic flavor
- Beautiful coloring
- Excellent, large size
- High tolerance to bacterial leaf spot

# PREVIEW H65-76



- New Rutgers release coming...
- Late-season yellow freestone peach
- Ripens around Encore and Laurole season, 36 days after Redhaven
- Very large size
- Hangs well on tree
- Excellent flavor and coloring
- High tolerance to bacterial leaf spot
